<sup>1</sup> The gospel beginneth with the preaching of John the Baptist. <sup>9</sup> Jesus is baptized, witnessed to from heaven; <sup>12</sup> and tempted of the devil: <sup>14</sup> preacheth in Galilee; <sup>16</sup> calleth Peter, Andrew, James, and John: <sup>23</sup> healeth one possessed of an unclean spirit, <sup>29</sup> Simon's mother in law, <sup>32</sup> and various other diseased persons: <sup>35</sup> prayeth alone, and goeth on to preach: <sup>40</sup> cleanseth a leper.

**1** THE <sup>a</sup>beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, <sup>b</sup>the Son of God;

<sup>2</sup> As it is <sup>c</sup>written in the prophets, <sup>d</sup>Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.

<sup>3</sup> <sup>e</sup>The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.

<sup>4</sup> <sup>f</sup>John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance <sup>1</sup>for the <sup>\*</sup>remission of sins.

<sup>5</sup> <sup>g</sup>And there went out unto him all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, <sup>h</sup>confessing their sins.

<sup>6</sup> And John was <sup>i</sup>clothed with camel's hair, and with a girdle of a skin about his loins; and he did eat locusts and wild honey;

<sup>7</sup> And preached, saying, <sup>j</sup>There cometh one mightier than I after me, the <sup>\*</sup>latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose.

<sup>8</sup> <sup>k</sup>I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy <sup>\*</sup>Ghost.

<sup>9</sup> <sup>l</sup>And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from <sup>m</sup>Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan.

<sup>10</sup> And straightway coming up

out of the water, he saw the heavens <sup>2</sup>opened, and the <sup>n</sup>Spirit like a dove descending upon him:

<sup>11</sup> And <sup>o</sup>there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

<sup>12</sup> <sup>p</sup>And immediately the Spirit driveth him into the wilderness.

<sup>13</sup> And he was there in the wilderness forty days, <sup>\*</sup>tempted of Satan; and was <sup>w</sup>with the wild beasts; and the angels <sup>v</sup>ministered unto him.

<sup>14</sup> Now after that <sup>s</sup>John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching <sup>t</sup>the gospel of the kingdom of God,

<sup>15</sup> And saying, <sup>u</sup>The time is fulfilled, <sup>v</sup>and the kingdom of God is at hand: <sup>w</sup>repent ye, and believe the gospel.

<sup>16</sup> <sup>x</sup>Now as he walked by the sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.

<sup>17</sup> And Jesus said unto them, Come ye after me, and I will make you to become <sup>y</sup>fishers of men.

<sup>18</sup> And straightway they forsook their nets, and followed him.

<sup>19</sup> And when he had gone a little further thence, he saw James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, who also were in the ship mending their nets.

<sup>20</sup> And straightway he called them: and they <sup>z</sup>left their father Zebedee in the ship with the hired servants, and went after him.

<sup>21</sup> <sup>a</sup>And they went into Capernaum; and straightway on the sabbath day he entered into the synagogue, and taught.
